Over the last decade+, I've given more than 500 presentations to groups as small as six and as large as 4,500. During that time, I've figured out what works best for my presentations.

To get the most out of your event and to keep things easy for me, I've put together this list of requirements and suggestions.

- 1. I will use my own laptop (MacBook Pro) for the presentation and will provide my own HDMI/VGA adapters.
- 2. I will need a projector with VGA or HDMI connection and screen.
- 3. My laptop is controlled by a remote control that I will bring with me. There should be a table (or podium/chair, whatever you have, just so it can fit my laptop) within sight for me to set up my laptop. Off to the side of stage/room is preferred so it's not in the way.
- 4. For any groups larger than 40 people, I will need a wireless microphone.
- 5. If you've got it, a bottle of water would be appreciated.
